MAIN THOUGHT & OUTLINE

Whoever might be conspiring against the church, you can cry out to Christ with complete confidence that he will hear and help.

- I. Confident Crying (v.1)
- II. Confidence God Will Hear (v.2-5)
- III. Confidence God Will Help (v.6-8)

QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION & DISCUSSION

1. Do you agree with Dale Ralph Davis that “Biblical prayer seems to ponder God a good deal more than we are prone to do”? How can you correct this in your own prayers?
2. If God doesn’t hear the unbeliever’s prayers, on what basis can we tell an unbeliever to cry out to the Lord for mercy?
3. When you get angry, how often is it a righteous anger? What must we do with unrighteous anger and wrath?
4. How have you dealt with sleepless nights in the past? How can you apply Psalm 4 in your own life?
5. In trouble, is your first response to cry out to the Lord? Why or why not? Are you growing in confidence in Him?
