MAIN THOUGHT & OUTLINE

Jesus' love for his own people is a love which lasts all of his life and all of theirs.

QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION & DISCUSSION

1. How much do you consider what the love of Christ means for you post-conversion? What comfort does this bring you?
2. Why do you think it is so difficult to accept the extent of Christ's love for you? How much do you think we measure Christ's love by our own weak and inconsistent love for him?
3. How should Christ's love for us affect how we love him and live for him? What would be the right response to such love?
4. Consider verses 2-17 in context of verse 1 – what does Jesus' washing his disciples' feet have to do with love? How does it foreshadow the cross?
5. How should Christ's love for us affect our love for our neighbour?
