SIN IS LAWLESSNESS 1 JOHN 3:4-6

MAIN THOUGHT & OUTLINE

Every sin you commit is a horrific act of rebellion against God, requires Christ's work to take it away, and is not compatible with a life committed to Christ.

- **I.** Sin is a horrific act of rebellion against God (v.4)
- II. Sin requires Christ's work to take it away (v.5)
- III. Sin is not compatible with a life committed to Christ (v.6)

QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION & DISCUSSION

- 1. How should the definition of sin we've considered this afternoon spur us on to greater examination as we considered this morning?
- **2.** How do you respond to those who trivialize or even laugh at sin? Does John's definition change how you would respond?
- **3.** Do you ever ponder the weight of sin and the cost of your salvation in that light? How amazing is our God?!
- **4.** Are there other terms you need clearer definitions for? Consult the catechisms for clear, concise, biblical definitions on terms like "justification", "adoption", etc.
