MAIN THOUGHT & OUTLINE

Christ commands you as his disciples to treat those who mistreat you with love, and so reflect the mercy of your Heavenly Father.

- I. Commanded to Love (v.27-31)
- II. Commanded to Reflect Your Father's Mercy (v.32-36)

QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION & DISCUSSION

1. How does the context of Luke 6 help us rightly understand Christ's commands?
2. Are there particular personal situations that come to your mind when you read this passage? Have you applied this passage well to those situations?
3. Do you think of how God's treated you mercifully as you deal with how others treat you? What difference does this make to your actions?
4. Boys & girls – which command do you think is hardest? Who obeyed these commands perfectly? How can you obey?
