OUR LORD'S LAMENT, PART 2
PSALM 22:11-21A

MAIN THOUGHT & OUTLINE

Christ's lament teaches that, when enemies are near and God seems far, you can continue to cry out to heaven and seek deliverance from your God.

- I. Crying Out with Lament (v.11-18)
- II. Crying Out for Deliverance (v.19-21a)

QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION & DISCUSSION

- 1. How has this consideration of Psalm 22 already helped you bring your sufferings to God in a greater way?
- 2. Why is God's sovereignty in our suffering actually a place of comfort? Was it so for Jesus on the cross?
- 3. What does the way of Christ's deliverance teach us about how God will answer us when we call to Him?
- 4. Boys & girls – do you tell God about your struggles? Why do you think He'll listen to you?
