MAIN THOUGHT & OUTLINE

Glorify God for Jesus who mercifully opens the eyes of blind sinners to see and serve Him.

- I. Merciful Saving Sight Needed (v.35-39)
- II. Merciful Saving Sight Given (v.40-43)

1. How does spiritual blindness help us understand the confusion of our world? Do you remember what it was like to be spiritually blind before salvation?
2. What can we learn spiritually from this blind beggar's use of the means to find mercy for his greatest need?
3. What is your responsibility when Christ has opened your eyes? How are you following after Jesus?
4. Boys & girls – what does it mean to be spiritually blind? Why is Jesus the only solution to this blindness?
