THE SAVIOUR WEEPS OVER STUBBORN SINNERS
LUKE 19:41-44

MAIN THOUGHT & OUTLINE

The sight of the weeping Saviour over stubborn sinners calls us to know His heart, heed His gospel, and tremble at His judgement.

- I. Know the Saviour's Heart (v.41)
- II. Heed the Saviour's Gospel (v.42)
- III. Tremble at the Saviour's Judgement (v.43-44)

QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION & DISCUSSION

1. Does Jesus' heart and passion for your salvation move you to realize the seriousness of your own need? Will you heed the gospel call if you have not already, or will you ignore the warning of judgement?
2. As a believer, have you known about this heart of Jesus? Do you believe it for yourself, and for others still lost?
3. Have you ever wept for sinners? Does Christ's heart and passion for salvation move you to such a care for the lost? Perhaps those once in the church but have rejected Him, or those you've witnessed to or invited to church?
4. Boys & girls – why did Jesus weep? Do you weep for sin?
